
## **GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING POSTERS**

Your poster should cover the KEY POINTS of your research work. The ideal poster is designed to:

- Attract attention with a short title (as per your full paper submission)
- Provide a brief overview of your work
- Prepare yourself for discussions and questions with visiting delegates during the poster session
- Use single paper of size B1 size: 707 x 1000 mm or 27.8 x 39.4 in



- The title of poster should appear at the top in CAPITAL letters **40 pts.**
- The paper number given by IC-RIDME must be written on the right top corner IC-RIDME18-XXX. Say your paper no. is 15, then 'XXX' will be '015'.
- The author(s) name(s) and affiliation(s) are put below the title -Arial/Calibri-24 pts.
- The running text in the poster should be **25 pts.** [Arial/Cambria] and the important points should be in a bold. Make your poster as self explanatory as possible. The **lettering should be large enough to be legible from 5 ft (1.5 m) distance.**
- The provided poster boards would be vertical and are to measure 1100 mm x 1200 mm. Prepare your poster with longer side of B1 being the height.
- Your paper should fit within the board. The printed material should have 1" (25 mm) margins all around it.
- The texts and figures below the names may be prepared in a single column (full width) or in two columns.
- Carefully prepare your poster well in advance of the conference. There will be no time or materials available for the preparations or printings at the

conference. If you think you may need certain materials to repair the poster after travelling, BRING THEM WITH YOU. Print and carry the poster in a hard paper box.

- Use color to highlight and make your poster more attractive, by using pictures, diagrams, cartoons, figures etc., rather than only text wherever possible. The text inside the figures should be 14 pts.
- Figures and table should be large and clear for legibility at 5ft (1.5m) distance.
- Print the final version in a B1 size paper in a large printer. You may bring push pins/Velcro with you.

Important: Your poster must be posted at least 1 hour prior to the declared presentation time and removed immediately after the session, as per the schedule.
